

Psalm 23:1

From the Pastor...

In the verses preceding verse 27, chapter 11 of Luke, Jesus is casting out demons and responding to claims that he does this by the power of Beelzebul. The passage continues, "²⁷While he was saying this, a woman in the crowd raised her voice and said to him, "Blessed is the womb that bore you and the breasts that nursed you!" ²⁸But Jesus said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it!""

"Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it." This seems like an easy enough task to do: hear and obey. But notice it says hear the word of God, not the word of the culture that tells us that more is better, rich is more blessed and outward beauty is better than inner beauty, among other messages. Hear the word of the God.

Even here there can be problems. Some people only want to hear part of the word of God, the parts they agree with such as passages referring to homosexuality or the place of women in society or slavery or views of war and murder. Those who do this proof texting often overlook (on purpose) the umbrella that covers the entirety of scripture.

Our God is a God of love and our purpose in this life is to honor and love God with all our hearts, minds and souls and our neighbor as ourselves. That is what Jesus calls us to do. We are also called to share this love with those we meet, whether we like them or not.

I would encourage you as you contemplate our Nation's freedom this July to also contemplate and enact the freedom you have in Christ to love without restrictions, and to honor all creation and humanity and to love God our Creator with all your being. ²⁸But Jesus said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it!"
